• **Mozambique, Malawi and Zimbabwe – Cyclone Idai**

The terrible Cyclone hit our brothers and sisters in all three countries very hard. Armino Magule, Overseer Mozambique and Celia Mendes, Missionary to Mozambique immediately surveyed the situation in the regions that were hit the most. Meanwhile help has been extended to many of our church people and beyond. World Missions Director, Dr. David Griffis responded instantly to this tremendous need and funds were released. In addition, Christopher Sibale, Overseer of Malawi surveyed the situation in his areas. He has distributed food and other necessary items. The need is immense and people are in despair. Zimbabwe also has started with the distribution.



• **Bidi Bidi Refugee Camp**

We received an exciting report from John Komi, Overseer South Sudan about a Gospel Outreach in the Bidi Bidi Camp, which at present is the biggest Refugee Camp worldwide. Bro. Komi, himself being a refugee desires to spread the Good News of Jesus Christ to as many of his own people as possible. During the recent outreach, 64 received Christ as their savior and all were baptized in water. Since there was no river nearby they dug a hole, put in plastic sheets and filled it with water. In the near future he is planning more crusades in order to reach all South Sudanese tribes represented in the camp.



• **Firewall Seminars**

In Angola, Zambia, Mozambique and Bidi Bidi Camp (South Sudanese refugees) Raymond Lombard and his team organized Firewall Seminars. Several hundred Pastors attended the Training sessions and went out to share Jesus Christ in the communities. Great numbers accepted Christ as their savior. The Firewall Initiative has motivated many pastors and evangelists to be involved in personal witnessing by using the Heart Chart. In Bidi Bidi Camp a



convert from an UPG (Unreached People Group), the Murle Tribe has been reached and a church was planted. Through the wonderful Ministry of **“Wheels for God’s Word”** several hundred bicycles were donated to pastors and evangelists to become mobile for Jesus.



• **Cafeteria at Berea College**, Lusaka, Zambia is nearing completion. We give praise to God for His provisions to provide the College with a beautiful much-needed place to cook and eat.
